

God's Promises

In your hands you are holding a “Promise from God.” You have a choice to make, you can believe that this promise is God breathed or it is not. But before we ask if you believe that this promise is from God, let us ask you a few questions about what you believe.

When I ponder this promise of God that I hold in my hands I must have a clear understanding of the following questions:

1. Who do I say God is? (Genesis 1:27)
2. What do I believe about Jesus Christ? (John 3:16 - Romans 10:9)
3. Is there an “enemy” who will try to keep me from this Promise?
(We know that Satan is an enemy, but who else is the enemy?)
4. Is my “destiny” a matter of choice or chance? (Matthew 6:19-21)
5. Do I believe that this “Promise from God” is specifically for me?
6. What role does my “religion” play in my relationship to God? (Romans 5:1)

After answering these questions, you have a choice: (Psalm 25:12)

- A. You can put your trust in God's Word to guide you. (John 16:13)
“Or”
- B. You can put your trust in man's word to guide you.
